You can help eliminate crime by remembering these important safety tips:

<u>DO</u>

- Always lock your car!
- Keep your windows rolled up.
- Lock valuables in your trunk away from public view.
- Park in well-lit areas and pay attention to your surroundings.

DO NOT

- ... leave items in plain view, i.e., IPODS, GPS or holder, cell phones, laptops, purses, etc.
- ... leave remote garage door openers in vehicles.
- ... leave an engine running when you are away from the vehicle.
- ... keep original ownership papers in vehicle.
